TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please read this important information carefully. The payment of a deposit of any part or full payment for a reservation on this tour shall constitute consent to all of the provisions contained herein.

Payment Schedule

A deposit of \$1,000 per passenger is required to book on a tour. Balance of payment is due 120 days prior to departure. Pre-departure documents and permission to board the vessel are only obtained once full payment and all forms have been received. Adventure Canada, provider of this service, is a member in good standing of TICO. The Ontario Travel Compensation Fund insures all payments (for more information on the Fund visit <http://www.tico.on.ca/consumers/compfund.html>). For wire transfers, please note your financial institution will likely charge a service fee, this fee is at your expense. Please ensure that amount owed to your booking agent is paid in full. Returned cheques are subject to a \$25 CDN fee.

Cancellations and Refunds

All requests for cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellations received at least 120 days prior to departure are fully refunded less an administrative penalty of \$500 per passenger. If cancellation is made between 91 and 120 days, cancellation is 65% of cruise cost. Please note that within the 90-day limit, all deposits and tariffs are forfeited. For these and other reasons mentioned below you are strongly advised to obtain trip cancellation insurance. Prices quoted are based on group participation and no refunds will be made for any part of the program in which you choose not to participate. It is understood that refunds cannot be made to passengers who do not complete the tour for any reason whatsoever.

Delays

In the event of a delay passengers will be responsible for additional meals, hotel expenses, transfer and flight changes should they be required.

Baggage

Airline luggage allowance is restricted to two pieces per passenger with weights determined by air carriers. One piece of carry-on luggage is permitted. Excess baggage charges are the responsibility of each passenger.

Insurance

Due to the remoteness of the areas we visit, medical and emergency evacuation insurance is mandatory. Comprehensive trip cancellation and baggage insurance is recommended for coverage of expenses in conjunction with cancellation due to illness, accident or trip interruption. Uninsured passengers must accept full responsibility for costs or payments under any circumstances. Your booking agent offers a comprehensive line of insurance coverages to all its passengers.

Itinerary

The itinerary described is subject to change at the discretion of the ship's master. This is an expedition to a remote part of the world. Adventure Canada (AC) reserves the sole and exclusive right (at its discretion) to alter or omit any part of the itinerary or change any reservation, feature and/or means of conveyance without notice and for any reason whatsoever including but not limited to weather conditions, availability of anchorages, political conditions and other factors beyond our control and without allowance or refund and with any and all extra costs resulting therefrom paid by the passengers. We expressly reserve the right to cancel, without prior notice to the passengers, any tour prior to departure, in which case payment will be refunded without further obligation on our part including, but not limited to the payment of interest thereon. It is understood that such decisions will be made in the best interest of all passengers aboard and with regard to the safety of the vessel.

Zodiac Travel

Zodiac embarkations involve descending gangway stairs with double handrails and stepping into the Zodiac from a small platform at water level (assistance is provided throughout).

Responsibility

Adventure Canada (AC) is a subcharterer of the M/S Explorer. Prior to boarding the vessel, passengers will receive the ship's standard contract/liability waiver, the Passage Contract Ticket. Please read this document upon receipt. In accepting this Passage Contract Ticket, passengers agree to be bound by its terms and conditions. Passage Contract Tickets may be obtained from AC on written request.

While AC, its subsidiaries, and/or associated Agents and sponsoring organizations exercise reasonable care, we assume no liability whatsoever for any property loss or damage and or any damages resulting from illness, personal injuries or death which may be sustained by reason of, or while engaged on, any tour whether due to ownership, maintenance, use, operation or control of any manner or means of conveyance including, but not limited to ship, aircraft, helicopter, automobile, train, motor coach, bicycle, boat, vehicle, hotel, common carrier, or any other conveyance used in carrying out these tours for any reason whatsoever. We cannot and we do not accept any responsibility for any losses whatsoever whether caused by failure or delay or other irregularity, acts or omissions occurring during a tour under which the means of transportation or other service provided thereby is offered or supplied by owners, operators, or public carriers for whom AC acts only as agent. AC shall not be responsible for any injury to person (whether or not resulting in death), damage to property or additional expense or the like due to, or arising out of, any act of war, insurrection, revolt or other civil uprising or military action occurring in the countries of origin, destination or passage, or changes caused by sickness, weather, strike, quarantine, acts of God, force majeure, or other causes beyond our control. Any and all such losses shall be borne solely by the passenger, as tour rates provide for arrangements only for the time stated. AC strongly urges individual passengers to obtain any appropriate insurance coverage. Baggage is at the owner's risk entirely. AC will not be held responsible for inadequate travel documents – visas, passports, etc., are the responsibility of the passenger.

The transportation companies concerned are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time that passengers are not aboard their carriers or conveyances. The passenger understands and acknowledges the ticket in use by the carriers concerned (when issued) shall constitute the sole contract between the transportation companies and the purchaser of these tours and/or passage.
