Policies, General Information and Terms and Conditions

Reservations: We require that you complete and sign our Registration Form and return it to us along with a deposit of \$300 (USD or CDN) per person. If registering by phone, fax or email, a deposit must be received within 14 days or the space will be released. Invoices covering the balance due will be mailed approximately 90 days prior to departure. Payment is due upon receipt of the invoice. Deposits are insured by the BC Travel Assurance Fund.

Cancellation & Refund Policy: Notification of cancellation must be received in writing. Unless otherwise noted, the following policy applies: if cancellation is received up to 120 days prior to departure, full deposit and any payment, less a \$100 (USD and CDN) handling fee per person, will be refunded. If cancellation is received between 60 and 119 days prior to departure, 50% of the tour fee is not refundable. Thereafter, all deposits and payments are not refunded. Refunds cannot be made to participants who do not complete the tour for any reason.

Trip Insurance: We strongly recommend that you purchase trip cancellation insurance to cover your investment in case of injury, illness or some other unexpected event which forces you to cancel. In addition, we recommend that you obtain emergency medical insurance that covers expenses resulting from accidental injury or illness during the tour.

Medical Information: Participation on an Eagle-Eye tour requires that you are in generally good health, able to complete gentle walks of several hours duration and to meet the tour's schedule. Persons with medical problems or dietary restrictions must make them known to us well in advance of the tour. Eagle-Eye Tours has the authority to disqualify any participant, without refund, if the tour leader feels that the individual's continued participation will jeopardize the wellbeing of the individual or the group.

Tour Size: We believe that small groups are essential for a high quality, enjoyable experience. In general, our group sizes have 4 to 8 participants with a single leader and 9 to 12 people with two leaders. Many of our tours are restricted to a maximum of 8 participants. When two leaders are listed, the second leader will accompany the tour only if it is sufficiently subscribed. If a tour does not receive enough registrations, a small group supplement may have to be charged.

Tour Fees: We will make every effort to charge the prices quoted in our catalog or detailed itineraries, but fluctuations in major currencies may force us to change tour prices at any time before departure. Current prices are listed on our website. All fees are quoted in US and Canadian dollars and can be paid in either currency. Fees are based upon double occupancy. Single rooms, as available, will be provided upon request for an additional fee. For participants traveling alone but wishing to share a room, Eagle-Eye Tours will arrange for a roommate, if possible. If a roommate is not available, the single supplement will be charged. Our tour fees include all lodging, ground transportation, in-country air transportation, guide services, park and special entrance fees, and baggage handling for those requiring assistance. Outside the USA and Canada, all meals are included on our tours. Tours within the USA and Canada do not include evening meals. The tour fee does not include alcoholic beverages, transportation to or from the tour departure or conclusion points, passport and visa fees, airport taxes, phone calls, laundry, or other items of a personal nature.

Exclusion of Liability and Our Responsibility for your Tour: Clients bookings are accepted on the understanding that they appreciate the possible risks inherent in adventure travel and that they undertake the tours, treks or expeditions featured in our programme at their own volition. Due to political and cultural differences, as well as generally tougher physical conditions, travel to many areas of the world involves risks other than those we take in our daily lives. The Company and the tour operators it works with place extreme importance on the safety of clients. It is important, however, that clients realise that they are responsible for making themselves aware (through Government advisories, Government Tourist Offices and other sources of information) of the risks involved, and are responsible for making their decisions accordingly. The Company shall not be liable for any delays, deviations or omissions from any tour caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control, nor for any direct or indirect consequences thereto. The Company shall not be liable to compensate clients for associated expenses incurred as a result of their booking. The Company only acts as agent for the owners, contractors, suppliers of transportation and local operators/agents, and/or other related travel services provided and assumes no liability or responsibility for additional expenses howsoever caused arising directly or indirectly from the actions or omissions of such independent parties, accidents, loss or damage to person or property, delays, transport failures, strikes, war, force majeure, Acts of God etc, over which it has no control. Arrangements so made by the Company will be subject to any special terms imposed by the supplier of these services. The Company accept no liability for any action or activity undertaken by the client arranged independently of the Company while on tour. The Company accept no liability for any circumstance arising pursuant to the agreement constituted by acceptance of these conditions by the client save: a) where such circumstance derives directly from a failure by the Company to use due diligence in the selection of persons for whom it acts as agent; or b) for negligence on the part of its employees causing death or personal injury; or c) to the extent of recovery by the client under the insurance cover effected pursuant to these conditions.
